## REGISTRATION

- **Registration & Payment deadline:** **Monday, 02 February 2026 at 21:00**
- Registration of a player is only completed once Proof of Payment has been sent and the player is registered in the correct section.
- **NO LATE ENTRIES OR REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
- **THERE WILL BE NO REGISTRATION ON THE DAY OF THE EVENT.**
- Each school may only enter their **top 15 players**.
- A school may apply to register **more than 15 players**. A motivational email should be sent to Paul Wilson at [metronorthchairperson@gmail.com](mailto:metronorthchairperson@gmail.com) applying for these extra players.
- A maximum of **250** players will be allowed to participate in each event.
- Withdrawal of players must be done no later than Thursday, 05 February 2026 at 17:00 (Primary School) and Thursday, 12 February 2026 at 17:00 (Secondary Schools). Notice must be sent to Paul Wilson at [metronorthchairperson@gmail.com](mailto:metronorthchairperson@gmail.com).
- No refunds of entry fees paid will be made for players that withdraw from the tournament after the closing date.

## TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

- **PLAYERS TO BE SEATED BY 08h45 FOR ANNOUNCEMENTS**
- **SAFEGUARDING:** Please note that player/s remain the responsibility of their school or parents. It is, therefore, essential for a guardian to accompany the players
- **AGE GROUPS:** Players must compete in the age group they currently qualify for and are NOT permitted to play in a higher or lower age group.
- **FORMAT:** Please note that this is a Swiss system event, not a knockout event. Players are not eliminated after losing a match and are required to complete all the rounds as specified. Failure to do so will result in a reduction of rating points.
- **TIME CONTROL:** 55+5 SPM
- **DEFAULT TIME:** There is no Default time for the first round for all sections of the tournament.  
Players who are not seated at their board at the scheduled starting time of the first round will be removed from the pairings and their opponents may be manually paired with another available player.  
The subsequent Default time is **10 minutes** from **round 2**
- **TIE BREAKS:**
  1. Direct Encounter
  2. Buchholtz
  3. Sonnenborn-Berger
  4. Average Opponent Rating
  5. Most Victories
- **NOTATION:** It is compulsory for under 11, 13, 15, 17 and 19 players to notate their games in accordance with the laws of Chess. Notation sheets will be provided. Players must provide their own pens.
- Appeals must be done in writing and accompanied by a R200 fee (refundable if appeal is successful).
- Appeals must be done within 20 minutes of the incident of the round in question and before the publishing of the next round.
- Written appeal will contain a copy of the notation of the game in contention. Without the evidence (written appeal and notation) no dispute will be entertained.
- No parents or spectators are allowed in the designated playing area.
- All players must wear their school attire. Players will not be allowed to play if they do not wear their school attire.
- Players that have finished their games shall leave the playing hall; not return before the next round.
- No game analysis can be done in playing area.
- Players must make sure the results are recorded correctly.
- Photographs of the players may be taken during the event & during prizegiving. All players are deemed to allow publication of photographs of them taken at the event by the organisers for publicity purposes unless they inform the organizers otherwise.
- The use of cell phones, smartwatches, or any electronic devices is strictly prohibited in the playing area. If a player is found in possession of any such device during a match, they will immediately forfeit the game.
- The players are not allowed to eat food or snacks during the games. One cool drink per player in a container with a sports cap will be allowed at the table.
- We currently do not have enough clocks for all the players. If you have any available, please bring them along.
- By completing the registration, the parent/guardian/player gives consent for the publication of the player's name, surname, gender, date of birth, school & Chess SA ID on [www.chessresults.com](http://www.chessresults.com) for the purpose of tournament pairings and administration as well as submission to Chess SA for rating.
